



- 2. Effective on 3 April 2015, and shall be valid for a period of five (5) years.
- 3. Focus on:
 - A. Human Resource Development
 - B. Research and Development
 - C. Consultancy
 - D. Information Management and Networking.





1. Human Resource Development

2. Research and Development

- Conduct collaborative & joint research program using SEAFDEC research vessels
- Extension of technological advancements
- Promotion of:
 - Social development
 - Socio-economic well-being





3. Consultancy

 Collaborative consultancy by drawing on the expertise of SEAFDEC and CTI-CFF





4. Information, Management & Networking

- Information development, exchange and dissemination
- Cooperation in information networking





Mechanism for Implementation

- 1. Either party may <u>initiate proposals</u> for activities that would be carried out under current MOU.
- 2. Specific details for those activities shall be set forth in a <u>Letter of Arrangement</u> that shall include such terms as:
 - Elaboration of the <u>responsibilities</u> of each party
 - Schedule of implementation for the specific activity
 - Budgetary allocations and sources of funds for each activity
 - Any other necessary items for the efficient achievement of the activity
- 3. Both parties shall be responsible for the <u>evaluation</u> of these activities
