CHALLENGES

- Commitment: support for initiative, participation in TWGs, particularly through ratification and contributions from all member states
- Funding: Uncertain long term plans from countries and donors to finance the initiative
- Focus: breadth of scope makes it difficult to prioritize, fund, administer, measure.
- Coordination: synergize with other regional and national programs such as PIF, SSME, ATSEA, ASEAN, TPP, etc.

- Targeted NCC/Country advocacy to public funders for CTI-CFF RPOA support (e.g. support from Indonesian embassy for Europe roadshow).
- Finalise ratification and contributions from all member countries.
- Finalise inclusion of Brunei as seventh member state.
- Approval of GEF project to support M&E and Sustainable Finance across CTI-CFF.
- Continue engagement in global meetings to build visibility of CTI-CFF (e.g. Climate COP side event!)
