Adopted on 3rd December 2015 by the Governments of Indonesia, Malaysia, Papua New Guinea, the Philippines, Solomon Islands, and Timor-Leste

I. Background

During the 10th Senior Officials' Meeting in November 2014 in Dili, Timor-Leste, we acknowledged the progress made by the member countries in the implementation of NPOAs and at the same time encouraged the NCCs to renew and revalidate their NPOAs to cover the next 5 years. We also enjoined the countries to utilize the CTI-CFF Monitoring and Evaluation System in preparing country reports. In that meeting we tasked the Regional Secretariat to publish the country reports in the CTI-CFF website.¹

Given the above-mentioned decision points, the different countries continued their initiatives and reviewed their NPOAs.

II. Decision

Based on the presentation by the different National CTI-CFF Coordinating Committees and discussions during the session on *Country Reports* at SOM11, the Senior Officials hereby:

- 1. Acknowledged the activities and efforts of Indonesia, Malaysia, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, the Solomon Islands, and Timor-Leste in achieving the goals of their NPOAs and the RPOA.
- 2. Tasked the Regional Secretariat to compile and publish the country reports and evaluate the implementation of the National Plan of Actions (NPOAs) in relation to the Regional Plan of Action (RPOA).
