# **Updates since SOM 17**

10.5. Recognize the ongoing process to endorse and acknowledge the need to accelerate the appointment of a Board Status: Prospective Founding Board members have been selected by the Fund's Steering Committee

10.6. Task the Steering Committee (SC) to accelerate progress towards the establishment of RCTF by next Leader's Summit, noting the need for active participation of SC members to achieve this; Status: Steering Committee has been dissolved with the appointment of the prospective Founding Board; most of SC members have transitioned to Advisory Group. Trust Fund had a soft launch on Coral Triangle Day June 2023; aiming to have the independent fund launched by 2nd Quarter of 2024


10.7. Acknowledging the importance of international events (e.g., UNFCCC COP27 and CBD COP15) in the mobilization of resources for climate and biodiversity that can enable the achievement of RPOA2.0 and RCTF goals Status: Incoming Trust Fund CEO to tap on such international events for resource mobilization. Travel budget covered by PIO grant (USAID)

10.8. Noted on the need to deliberate the composition of the Board to ensure that the CT6 member countries is well represented;

Status: Four of the six prospective Founding Board members are from CT6.

# What is a Conservation Trust Fund

- **Private, legally independent**, mission-driven institutions that provide sustainable funding for nature conservation
- Created as independent entities to meet international donor expectations for transparency and accountability
- Secured by trust law (or similar regulation) that protects the assets and the beneficiaries (inside or outside country)
- Civil Society-led Board




### Outcome 3

Governments, civil society, private actors, indigenous peoples and local communities (IPLCs), and other actors have a sustainable economic relationship with the marine and coastal ecosystems.







#### • Hiring and Firing decisions


- Following international best practice, conservation trust funds are set up to be *private and legally independent institutions* that work to assist governments and stakeholders meet identified conservation objectives.
- Hiring and firing decisions related to the Trust Fund's CEO are *made by the Board* of the Trust Fund once the Fund is officially established.
- Identification of the CTCF Founding Board had CT6's involvement through the Fund's Steering Committee.

#### **Proposed point for SOM**

**Acknowledge** that RS will be hiring the CTCF "CEO" as a consultant under CTI-CFF RS until such time as the Fund is legally constituted; thereafter the CTCF CEO will be a staff of the Fund.
