Suggestions



- Exploring the potential merger of certain working groups, such as combining EAFM WG with CCA WG and TS WG with MPA WG, could lead to increased efficiency.
- 2. To enhance visibility, it is recommended that RS and CTI-CFF focus on publishing the science resource of the Coral Triangle.
- 3. Broaden the scope of CTI-CFF to encompass administrative boundaries, in addition to scientific boundaries.
- 4. Encourage Working Groups to increase their publication output based on their findings and outcomes.
- 5. Since the regulations do not specify the title Interim or others, it is recommended to use 'Acting Executive Director' for the Deputy Executive Director (DED) who will fulfill the ED's function.
- 6. To improve the overall effectiveness, it is recommended that the meeting representatives reports the meeting result to the Official Focal Point.
