### Term of Reference (TOR) for CTI Thematic Working Group

#### I. Background

CTI regional plan of action has agreed on achieving five overarching goal which need consistent and organized effort from CT6 and partners. Thematic Working Group is considered an important mean for successful implementation and achievement of CTI plan of action. To allow working groups deliver its objective, focal points from each CT country will be designated. Meetings and workshop to discuss issues, program, and recommendation shall be carried out.

#### II. Function

To provide technical inputs and recommendations to Regional Secretariat and National Coordination Committee (NCC), in achieving five overarching CTI goals that is stated at regional plan of action.

#### III. General term of reference

- Provide inputs and recommendations as required and tasked by SOM on specific goal by conducting regular meeting, workshop, consultation, and providing technical review and best approach/practice.
- Working group will be lead by a CT country, have a regular meeting, and work in accordance with CTI policy, program, and mechanism.
- Support regional secretariat in addressing cross cutting CTI goals in organizing thematic workshop and technical consultation and analysis.

#### IV. Tasks

- 1. To convene thematic WG meeting and discussions by creating CT6 team and partner for each theme.
- 2. To coordinate and assist identification, compilation, and consultation of thematic issues in CT6.
- 3. To assist regional exchange and workshop as public consultation.
- 4. To communicate with CT6 focal points, experts, partners, and other groups on specific theme.
- 5. To prepare technical and communication material on WG matters to be distributed to regional secretariat and CT countries.
