Background:

CTI-CFF has adopted nine Regional-level Priority Actions in May 2010 based on the 37 actions identified in the Regional Plan of Action (RPOA) adopted by the CTI Leaders Summit in Manado in May 2009. Progress of these nine priority activities were presented by various TWGs and a follow up actions are proposed to complete nine priority actions and identify a new set of priorities. This roadmap is a consolidation of activities proposed by various TWGs and adopted by the SOM in the earlier sessions.

Objective:

As the Secretariat was asked to play a more proactive role in facilitating CT6 governments, including direct consultation and engagement with the countries there was a need for a centralized calendar and roadmap for planning of regional level activities. This ROADMAP is to serve these two purposes, organizing and defining the activities of the CTI at the regional level and conducting early actions order to have a systematic and well-paced approach in implementing priorities actions in 2013
