Meetings: One set of business attire is advised should there be for most of the meeting.

Health Considerations: Please make sure you have adequate prescriptions with you if needed and that you travel with these. Kindly notify the meeting organizers in advance if you have any health conditions.

MEALS: Lunch and coffee breaks will be provided each day at the meeting venue during the meetings.

CURRENCY: The Indonesian Rupiah is the official currency in Indonesia. Money changers may be found just outside the arrival area at the Manado Airport before going to the venue. Banks and ATMs may also be found throughout Manado.











ELECTRICITY: Electricity in Manado, Indonesia is 220/240 Volts; power socket type C and type F. Travelers from most nations in Asia and Europe should have appliances that work on the same mains voltage as Indonesia, and therefore will not need a voltage converter. If your country does not use the power socket type C or type F, please be advised to have a universal travel power adapter. This enables you to plug your appliance into the sockets in Indonesia. Simply put, you plug your appliance into the power adapter and then plug the power adapter into the wall socket in Manado.
