#### Background

The Marine Protected Area Technical Working Group (MPA TWG) is among the five Technical Working Groups of the CTI-CFF that is supporting the six member countries (Indonesia, Malaysia, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Solomon Islands and Timor Leste) to attain the goals and targets of the Regional Plan of Action (RPOA), particularly Goal 3: "Marine Protected Areas (MPAs) Established and Effectively Managed".

The conduct of the MPA Regional Exchange, (MPA REX) that is linked to a MPA Technical Working Group (MPA TWG) Meeting, is crucial because this serves as a monitoring element of the CTI to assess and evaluate the performance of the CT6 in terms of contribution to the attainment of the goals and targets of the CTI-CFF Regional Plan of Action. The MPA Technical Working Group is responsible to provide updates/reports to the Senior Officials on the progress of goals and targets of Goal 3.

The MPA-TWG is conducting its annual meeting to review the progress of accomplishment both at the national and regional levels and jointly identify priority activities that will be endorsed to SOM for adoption/implementation, among others
